The Parks Department is gearing up for our Ppring events and getting the parks in shape as well. Our mowing schedule is starting to take off and the team is ready for the challenge. We are also excited about involving the community with our park’s beautification efforts. Elizabeth has set up a volunteer opportunity for the public to work alongside the Parks Department at Morris park. We anticipate this to be a time when the staff can interact with the folks that use and enjoy the park daily.

**Programs -Elizabeth**

February brought the love and began with our *Valentine’s Cards for Kids in the Hospital* event where 8 members of our community came together to craft unique and uplifting cards for hospitalized kids spending Valentine’s day away from their loved ones. It set the tone of volunteerism for the month where our *Teen Council* took off and boasts 9 members total who will work to create content for teens and young adults in our community. They are learning real world experiences where they will plan and execute events using a real budget and resources provided by the Park’s Dept. We then hosted two revenue generating events where participants bought tickets for the event, Ballroom Dancing and our Cooking Class. Ballroom Dancing hosted 8 participants, that paid \$15 each, who were enthusiastic about the concept of a series of dance classes in the future, and the cooking class had 6 participants, that paid \$20 each, who asked for additional, more advanced classes in the future.
