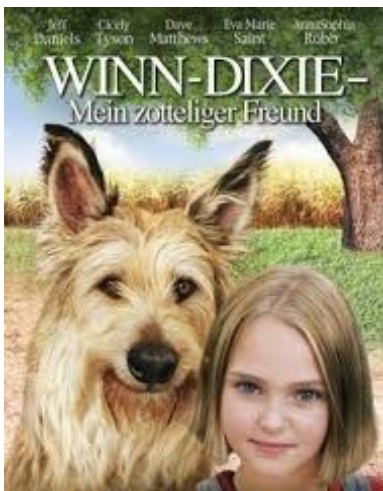
J. MICHAEL DOLAN
