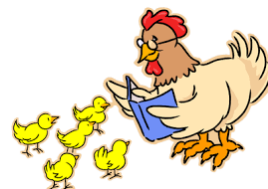

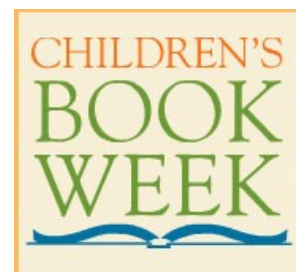


CHILDREN'S BOOK WEEK

Families will share a book and a craft. Dinner will be provided! Sign-up required.

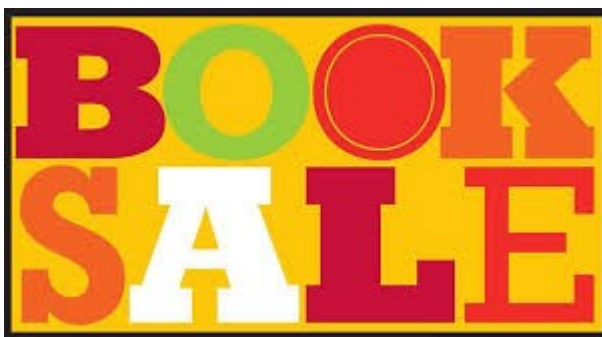


SIDEWALK BOOK SALE

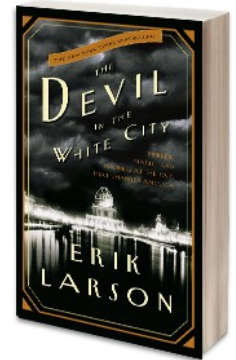
