Dear Arts and Crafts Vendors:

The Hogeye Festival will celebrate its 21<sup>st</sup> year in 2008. Producing one of the best festivals in Central Texas is a team effort that involves volunteers, local businesses, vendors, the city, and of course a great audience. In order to continue being a great festival with attendance of 15,000-25,000, and to capitalize on the target marketing of high quality arts and crafts from our vendors, we are implementing a few changes for 2008.

- Arts & Crafts vendors must submit a jury fee of **\$10** with photos and descriptions of their work. **The jury fee is non-refundable.**
- Applications without photos, clear color copies of photos or digital images submitted electronically will not be processed.
- Arts & Crafts vendor fees will be \$100 per 10x10 space before October 1<sup>st</sup> and \$125 after October 1<sup>st</sup>. The vendor fee is non-refundable.
- Manufactured or resale merchandise will not be accepted for an arts and crafts booth. Please do not submit an application unless the work is your own creation, handmade and of good quality.
- **No refunds in case of rain. No refunds after July 1, 2008.**

We appreciate your participation and encourage you to invite friends and associates with qualifying work to participate in the Hogeye Festival.
