The purpose of the Citizen Police Academy is to foster better communication between Citizens and the police through education. The academy creates a core of well-informed Citizens who possess greater insight into police practices and services.

Graduates of the academy are encouraged to share their knowledge and experiences with others in the community as the opportunity arise. Everyone benefits from enhancing citizen understanding of the role and function of their police department.



The academy consists of a twelve-week class which meets once a week which begins February 16th, 2012 with a pizza party. Each class consists of a two and a half to three-hour block of instruction on Thursday nights from 6:30 pm - 9:30 pm. This instruction is comprehensive, covering a different area of the Police Department each week. Certified police officers, supervisors, and civilian instructors, with particular expertise, will conduct each topic.

This dynamic program is offered to Elgin residents or business owners who are at least 18 years of age & have no felony convictions.
