Adult Interest

Periodically, the Elgin library holds Book Talks. Authors talk about writing and producing their books and finish the talk with a signing.

The Afternoon Book Club meets the second Tuesday of the month in the library at 2:00 p.m. The monthly list of books is available on bookmarks at the front desk. Patrons are encouraged to join the monthly discussion group or just read the books on their own.

Elgin Library is a convenient location for adults needing to work on their laptop. The library has free wi-fi access. Computers are available for internet research and email.

Study rooms are also available for the adult who is going back to earn a degree and is needing a place to study.

Librarians do and can serve as proctors for exams.

Children Programs

Our library is dedicated to serving the children in our community. We offer programs such as Lapsit for mothers to experience early literacy with their newborns to two years old. We have Breakfast with Books @ the Library to encourage reading and exploring the library. A weekly story time is geared for students 2—12 years of age year round, and once a month in the evening, story time and a movie night is offered for the whole family. Special programs consists of the Summer Reading programs for children ages 2—18,
