



1. Placement of the booths will be at the discretion of the Hogeye Committee. Arts & Crafts booths will be located back to back in the center of the street.

2. No participant will be allowed to set-up without a signed and dated application, liability release, and paid booth fee. Food vendors must have a current Bastrop County Retail Food Operation Permit.

3. **All fees are nonrefundable.** Inclement weather will not be grounds for refund.

4. No "boom" boxes or recorded music will be allowed in booth areas.

5. No exclusive rights for the sale of any item will be granted to a vendor.

6. No silly string, poppers, water guns or water balloons, or similar devices may be sold at the festival.

7. The Festival Committee reserves the right to inspect merchandise during set up and throughout the day. They will request that commercially manufactured, resale, and flea market items be removed from display and sale or that the vendor close the booth. **Sale of these items is prohibited. Booth fees will not be refunded to vendors selling commercially manufactured, resale or flea market items.**

8. Soda, sport drinks, flavored water (except tea and lemonade) and alcoholic beverages are the sole concession of the Greater Elgin Chamber of Commerce, the Veterans of Foreign Wars and the American Legion and may not be provided by any vendor.

9. No booth space shall be granted to those wishing to express religious, moral, or political opinions. Display of information of that nature will result in expulsion from the event without recourse or refund.

10. The Hogeye Committee reserves the right to revoke or refuse to grant space at any time, without recourse by the participant. The Hogeye Committee shall not be liable to anyone for this action. Processing of your payment does not guarantee acceptance or booth space at the festival.

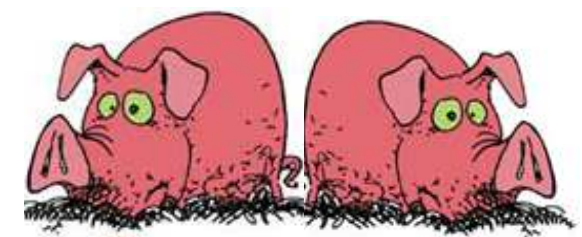

SET-UP

Exhibitors will be responsible for all booth structures, set-up, and furnishings, e.g. tables, chairs, extension cords, signage, drapes, etc. Vendors can begin check-in and booth set up at 6:30 a.m. on Saturday, October 24, 2009. **There is NO set up the night before the festival.** Booths must be ready by **9:30 a.m.** No booths will be allowed to close early. Absolutely no stakes may be used to secure pop-up canopies. Booth spaces are located on asphalt streets. No assistance for set up or tear down is available.

TEAR-DOWN

Participants are responsible for dismantling their booths and cleaning the space before leaving. Dumpsters provided.

FACILITIES

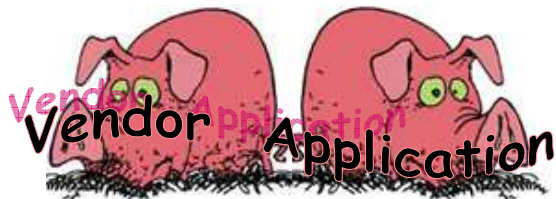
Electricity will be available for food/drink booths **only** if requested at the time of registration. **Arts & Crafts booths will NOT have access to electricity.**
