

**ORDINANCE NO. 2010-06-15-07**

**AN ORDINANCE AMENDING CHAPTER 1, SECTION 14, PARK REGULATIONS, CODE OF ORDINANCES, CITY OF ELGIN, TEXAS; PROVIDING FOR A SAVINGS CLAUSE AND REPEALING CONFLICTING ORDINANCES OR RESOLUTIONS.**

**BE IT ORDAINED BY THE COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF ELGIN, TEXAS, THAT:**

**I.**

That Chapter 1, Section 14, F (1) – (7) Parks and Recreation Department User Fees, Code of Ordinances, City of Elgin is hereby amended to read as follows:

**F. PARKS AND RECREATION DEPARTMENT USER FEES**

**(1) Facility/Equipment Rental**

- (a) Individuals, clubs, groups or firms may rent parks and recreational facilities for special functions where available, at the following fees:

Reservation of Pavilion/Covered Space	\$ 82.50 per day
Tennis Courts	\$ 82.50 per day
Sports Field	\$165.00 per field per day
Youth Sports Association	\$ 27.50 per team, per season
Concession Stand	\$ 55.00 per day
Open Area/Uncovered Space	\$ 45.00 per day
Refundable Deposit	\$100.00 per event

- (b) Parks and Recreation Director shall establish a schedule of fees for the daily rental of sports equipment.
- (c) City of Elgin employees may rent a pavilion or covered space for free two times per year (maximum two days annually) for private family use. City employees must provide the refundable deposit. This does not apply to special events or pool facility.

**(2) Sports Facility Light Fee**

Individuals, clubs, organizations, groups, or firms shall be charged twenty-seven and fifty (\$27.50) per hour for the use of sports facility lights.

**II.**

That Chapter 1, Section 14, G(1), Parks and Recreation Department User Fees, Code of Ordinances, City of Elgin is hereby amended to read as follows:

**G. MUNICIPAL POOL ADMISSION FEES:**

**(1) Municipal pool admissions:**

**(a) Daily Admission**

12 Years of age and under	\$ 1.25
13 Years of age and older	\$ 2.25

**(b) Swim Passes (12 Swims)**

12 Years of age and under	\$ 11.00
13 Years of age and older	\$ 25.00

**(c) Flex Pass**

55 swims all season, any age	\$ 65.00

**(d) Swimming Lessons**

Two (2) week Swim Lessons per child	\$ 75.00
-------------------------------------	----------

**(e) Water Aerobics**

four weeks of classes	\$ 30.00

**(f) Pool Rental by Private Party**

Under 50 Guests	\$100.00
50 - 100 Guests	\$200.00

Over 100 guests: fees are established by number of guards

Two hours maximum per pool party

(g) Employee Swim Passes

City of Elgin employees may receive free up to eight swim season passes including them selves and immediate family. Immediate families for purposes relating to herewith are spouse and children (biological, adopted, step, and primary care giver).

**III.**

A. All ordinances, parts of ordinances, or resolutions in conflict herewith are expressly repealed.

B. The invalidity of any section or provision of this ordinance shall not invalidate other sections or provisions thereof.

C. The City Council hereby finds and declares that written notice of the date, hour, place and subject of the meeting at which this Ordinance was adopted was posted and that such meeting was open to the public as required by law at all times during which this Ordinance and the subject matter hereof were discussed, considered and formally acted upon, all as required by the Open Meetings Act, Chapter 551, Texas Government Code, as amended.

Effective Date: This Ordinance shall be effective as of June 16, 2010.
