



## Elgin City Council Meeting Agenda Item Executive Summary

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**ITEM: A RESOLUTION BY THE CITY OF ELGIN, TEXAS, RESPONDING TO THE APPLICATION OF CENTERPOINT ENERGY ENTEX, SOUTH TEXAS DIVISION TO INCREASE RATES UNDER THE GAS RELIABILITY INFRASTRUCTURE PROGRAM; SUSPENDING THE EFFECTIVE DATE OF THIS RATE APPLICATION FOR FORTY-FIVE DAYS; DETERMINING THAT THE MEETING AT WHICH THE RESOLUTION WAS ADOPTED COMPLIED WITH THE TEXAS OPEN MEETINGS ACT; MAKING SUCH OTHER FINDINGS AND PROVISIONS RELATED TO THE SUBJECT; AND DECLARING AN EFFECTIVE DATE.**

**PROPOSED ACTION:** Approval of proposed rates Resolution.

**BACKGROUND:** Section 104.301 of the Texas Utilities Code allows municipalities the right to postpone proposed rate increases for 45 days in order that a review of the data and calculations can be made that was the basis for the utility to propose a rate adjustment. This proposed Resolution also allows the City of Elgin to participate in a coalition of other Cities in this particular rate case.

Residential rate \$2.04; general service small \$4.16; general service large volume \$27.20.

Increases will be suspended until July 11, 2019.
